

Seven years later, he completed his enlisted service as an Infantry Staff Sergeant. His final duty position in the U.S. Corps of Engineers was Deputy Commanding General, 412th Theater Engineer Command, where he was responsible for three Engineer brigades composed of over 12,000 Soldiers and civilians. In addition, he was the Wartime Engineer for the 8th U.S. Army in the Republic of Korea.
