CITY OF ABSECON

ORDINANCE 15-2015

**AN ORDINANCE MODIFYING SECTION 330-32 OF THE CODE OF
THE CITY OF ABSECON PROHIBITING LEFT HAND TURNS BY
NORTHBOUNDVEHICULAR TRAFFIC TRAVELLING ON ROUTE 9
INTO LOTS 2, 3 AND 11 IN BLOCK 289**

WHEREAS, a multiunit housing project has been approved for lots 2, 3 and 11 in block 289 as shown on the tax map of the City of Absecon with site plan approval for the same being granted by the Absecon Planning Board on July, 22, 2014; and

WHEREAS, the project for which said approval was granted is commonly referred to as the Conifer project; and

WHEREAS, when granting said approval the Board recommended that left hand turns into the entrance and exit ways of the Conifer project by traffic travelling northbound on Route 9 be prohibited; and

WHEREAS, the developers of the Conifer project have agreed to this prohibition; and

WHEREAS, by letter dated July 6, 2015 the State Department of Transportation project engineer, Kenneth Spigle indicated that the Department of Transportation has no objection to the left hand turn prohibition; and

WHEREAS, the Council of the City of Absecon is desirous of establishing such a prohibition.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the municipal Council of the City of Absecon, New Jersey as follows:

1. Section 330-32 of the Code of the City of Absecon shall be modified to prohibit left hand turns by Northbound vehicular traffic on Route 9 into the Conifer project which will be located on lots 2, 3, and 11 in block 289 as shown on the official tax map of the City of Absecon.
2. The City engineer, public works department and any other appropriate official of the City of Absecon is authorized to take any and all action so that no left hand turn signs are placed in a sufficient manner and number so as to notify the motoring public of the prohibition.
3. All such signs must be constructed and placed in conformity the manual on Uniform Traffic Control Devices for streets and highways.

4. A copy of this ordinance must be forwarded to the Commissioner of the Department of Transportation for approval within five days after adoption.

If any section, paragraph, subsection, clause or provision of this Ordinance shall be declared by a body of competent jurisdiction to be invalid, such adjudication shall apply only to the section, paragraph, subsection, clause or provision declared invalid and the remainder of the Ordinance shall remain in full force and effect.

Any ordinances of parts thereof in conflict with the provisions of this Ordinance are repealed to the extent of such conflict.

This Ordinance shall take effect following adoption and publication in the time and manner prescribed by law.

RESOLUTION 170-2015

**A RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING AND ADOPTING
A COMPLETE STREETS POLICY FOR THE CITY OF ABSECON**

WHEREAS, Complete Streets are defined as roadways that enable safe and convenient access for all users, including bicyclists, children, persons with disabilities, motorists, seniors, movers of commercial goods, pedestrians, and users of public transport; and

WHEREAS, the New Jersey Department of Transportation supports Complete Streets policies and adopted its own such policy on December 3, 2009; and

WHEREAS, the New Jersey Department of Transportation has established incentives within the Local Aid Program for municipalities to develop a Complete Streets policy; and

WHEREAS, the City of Absecon is committed to creating a pedestrian and bikeway system that makes walking and cycling a viable alternative to driving and which improves bicyclist and pedestrian safety; and

WHEREAS, the City of Absecon, desires to implement a Complete Streets policy through the planning, design, construction, maintenance and operation of new and retrofit transportation facilities within the public rights-of-way.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Council of the City of Absecon establishes and adopts the following Complete Streets policy.

1. Bicycle and pedestrian facilities shall be established in new construction and reconstruction projects unless one or more of the following conditions are met:
 - a. Bicyclists and pedestrians are prohibited by law from using the roadway;
 - b. The cost of accommodations is excessively disproportionate to cost of the project;
 - c. Where the sparse population, travel or other factors indicate an absence of need;
 - d. Detrimental environmental or social impacts outweigh the need for facilities;
 - e. The safety or timing of a project is compromised by the inclusions of facilities.
2. Bicycle and pedestrian facilities shall be designed in accordance with the best currently available local and national standards and practices.
3. Bicycle and pedestrian facilities shall be constructed, operated, and maintained so that all users, including people with disabilities, can travel safely and independently.
4. Exceptions to this policy are permitted and are contingent upon the presence of specific safety concerns and review by the City Engineer.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the City of Absecon will approach every transportation project and program as an opportunity to improve public streets and the transportation network for all users, and will work in coordination with other municipalities, agencies, and jurisdictions to achieve Complete Streets.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this Complete Streets policy shall be incorporated into the next reexamination, update, revision, amendment, or adoption of the Master Plan of the City of Absecon.
