**ORDINANCE 11-2017**

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE CODE OF THE CITY OF ABSECON,  
CHAPTER 330, VEHICLES AND TRAFFIC, SECTION 19, PARKING  
PROHIBITED AT ALL TIMES ON CERTAIN STREETS**

**WHEREAS**, the City of Absecon is authorized pursuant to state statute to establish certain areas where parking is prohibited; and

**WHEREAS**, Officials of the City of Absecon have reviewed all locations within the City where parking is prohibited; and

**WHEREAS**, the Council of the City of Absecon is desirous of amending Chapter 330, Section 19 of the code of the City of Absecon to eliminate streets where a parking prohibition is no longer necessary and to add streets where such a prohibition would advance the health, safety and welfare of residents and visitors to the City of Absecon.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED**, by the City Council of the City of Absecon, County of Atlantic, State of New Jersey, as follows:

**Section 1:** The portion of Chapter 330, Section 19 of the Code of the City of Absecon which designates streets or portions of streets as areas where parking is prohibited at all times is hereby repealed in the entirety and replaced with the streets and portions of streets listed on Exhibit A which is attached to this Ordinance and specifically made a part herein by this reference.

**Section 2:** Repealer: To the extent that any Ordinance or portion thereof contradicts this Ordinance, then said contradictory Ordinance or portion thereof is hereby repealed.

**Section 3:** Severability: To the extent that any portion of this Ordinance is declared invalid by a body of competent jurisdiction, then said section is severed from the remaining Ordinance and the remaining portions of this Ordinance shall continue in full force and effect.

**Section 4:** Effective Date: This Ordinance shall take effect upon final passage and publication pursuant to law.

**RESOLUTION 167-2017**

**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY OF ABSECON TO  
ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH SOUTH JERSEY ENERGY COMPANY  
FOR THE DELIVERY OF NATURAL GAS FOR USE BY THE CITY**

**WHEREAS**, on October 17, 2017 Camden County received bids for the South Jersey Power Cooperative, in which the City of Absecon participates, for the purchase of the commodity Natural Gas; and

**WHEREAS**, Concord Energy decided to lock in the commodity rate at \$4.9539 per dekatherm for a one year period with South Jersey Energy Company. The new Natural Gas commodity rate will be in effect for all natural gas accounts of the City.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, the Council of the City of Absecon, hereby authorizes the Mayor to enter into a contract with South Jersey Energy Company for a two year period commencing December, 2017 and ending November, 2019, for delivery of Natural Gas for use by the City of Absecon; with said prices being extended to Atlantic County/Cape May County Energy Cooperative Members during the life of the contract.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, The Mayor is hereby authorized to sign any related documents or agreements, including with third parties, necessary to implement the agreement authorized herein for the purchase and delivery of natural gas from South Jersey Energy Company.

**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE INSTALLATION OF  
TWO FIRE HYDRANTS ON EAST WOODLAND AVENUE**

**WHEREAS**, the City of Absecon has previously accepted the street known as East Woodland Avenue which includes two private fire hydrants;

**WHEREAS**, the existing account with New Jersey American Water (NJAW) for these two private fire hydrants will be closed and NJAW will remove these two existing private fire hydrants and install two new public fire hydrants in the same location;

**WHEREAS**, the City will accept financial responsibility for the two new fire hydrants at the typical public fire hydrant rate established by the New Jersey Board of Public Utilities;

**WHEREAS**, there will be no cost to the City for NJAW to remove and replace these hydrants, and NJAW will take over the maintenance of the fire hydrants.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, by the City Council of the City of Absecon that two fire hydrants on East Woodland Avenue will be replaced by NJAW; and

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that the City of Absecon will accept the financial responsibility for these hydrants at the public hydrant rate and that NJAW will be responsible for the removal and installation of the new hydrants and take over the maintenance of the hydrants.
