ORDINANCE 17-2021

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE CODE OF THE CITY OF ABSECON, CHAPTER 69 – POLICE DEPARTMENT ADDING SECTION 8 – POLICE CHAPLAIN

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MUNICIPAL COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ABSECON CITY, NEW JERSEY that Chapter 69-Police Department, be amended to add the following:

§ 69-8. Police Chaplain.

By Virtue of N.J.S.A. 40A:14-141, there is hereby created the honorary position of Police Chaplain in the Absecon City Police Department. The City of Absecon Council may appoint one or more Chaplains to the Police Department. Any person appointed to be Police Chaplin shall be an ordained clergyman in good standing in the religious body from which such person is selected. Such Chaplain shall become a member of the Municipal Police Department or force without rank and salary.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that:

- 1. Any Ordinance or parts of ordinances, which are inconsistent with the provisions of this Ordinance, are hereby repealed to the extent of any such inconsistency.
- 2. This ordinance shall take effect upon final adoption and publication as required by Law.
